At Rivet School, students earn their BA without having to leave their full time jobs. With the support of a personal coach and a wealth of wrap around resources, **we make college work for you.**

How our program works



An accredited BA: We enroll our students in an online, project-based degree program offered through a small number of curated partner universities. Each student gets a Rivet School-employed coach who provides personalized academic, motivational, and accountability support.



An affordable degree: All-in annual student cost is \$7,000, with no extra fees. We facilitate access to federal financial aid, which can reduce monthly out-of-pocket cost to as little as \$35. We also connect our students with interest-free loans, scholarships, and other responsible financing solutions.



An on-ramp to a great job: Rivet School students have access to career coaching and resources aligned to our career competencies (i.e. career planning). Students can also sign up for experience-building externships and other career development programs alongside their school work.



A world of resources: We support our students with access to co-working space, a free Chromebook (if they need it), and connections to community resources. We also foster community through regular social, academic, and career events, and through an online platform.
